**A wonderful example of vintage Moroccan Guigou, this piece has a strong chevron pattern executed in an unusual color palette. Berber symbolism includes cross forms, zig zags and X motifs within the large chevron belts. The side borders change stylistically, adding some irregularity to the otherwise symmetrical composition. A deep palette of faded plum, fig, truffle, sable brown, salmon, magenta, cognac and a brilliant indigo make this a stand out carpet. 100% wool.**
