A very unusual Beni Ouarain with an interesting motif structure. The pattern begins with a symmetrical grid, then suddenly shifts to an abstract lozenge network. The lozenges are interrupted by the signature of the weaver in Arabic. Woven in dark brown wool on an ivory ground. Some fringe loss present, consistent for a carpet of this age. 100% wool.
