A painterly Boujad with large distorted lozenge chains, some filled with recognizable Berber symbology while other areas take on a more creative approach. Asymmetrical side borders containing protection symbolism frame the composition. Knotted in an unusual palette of pale mint green, orange, light and dark sable brown, crimson red, and golden yellow. Fine silky wool pile on a cotton warp.
