A teal blue lozenge pattern lies just beneath the pile of cranberry red, tangerine, and light magenta wool. This carpet was woven to be reversible, showing its clear Berber message in the motifs on the back side. Can be used pile side down during warmer months and up during colder seasons, or reverse as you wish...this piece offers two unique carpets as one. 100% wool.
