This sizable Beni M'Guild features an intricate network of lozenges containing other traditional Berber symbols within. Male protection borders of four pointed star and cross motifs frame the composition. Knotted in a palette of abraded magenta, indigo, mossy green, orange, and ivory. The hues have faded over time, lending a warm patina and depth to the piece. 100% wool.
