An intriguing carpet from the plains region southwest of Marrakech full of character and a well loved patina. Two opposing double axe motifs near the center of the composition reflect a harmony between male and female symbology. They are flanked by large scale vertical lozenge bands filled with tree of life motifs. Acting as protection symbols, a cluster of bird's eye symbols float near the bottom of the composition. Borders with 8-pointed stars run along both selvages. Woven in an abrash of faded magenta, apricot, charcoal, and ivory, 100% wool.
