This monochromatic Boujad features layers of abraded poppy, carmine red, and pink with an overall lozenge network in ivory that appears etched into the surface. Bands of charcoal grey weft appear beneath the pile, lending depth and texture to the piece. Wool construction with the exception of some cotton in the warp. A time worn patina highlights this carpet's story.
